



The **KEY WORD** search finds a record that has both **JOHN** and **Baptist** and many citations will fit the bill, like this one. **KEY WORD** search looks in all fields, including the note field.

There will be some among the 1066 entries; but who has the time to search them all?

Now let's try the other way to search and see what we find.




